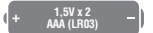

Requires two AAA batteries for remote control (not included) and six AA batteries for Dragonzord (included).  
Battery installation is required.  
Only adults should install batteries.  
Tool required for battery installation: Phillips screwdriver (not included).



Wipe toy with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse. This toy has no consumer serviceable parts. Do not take apart.

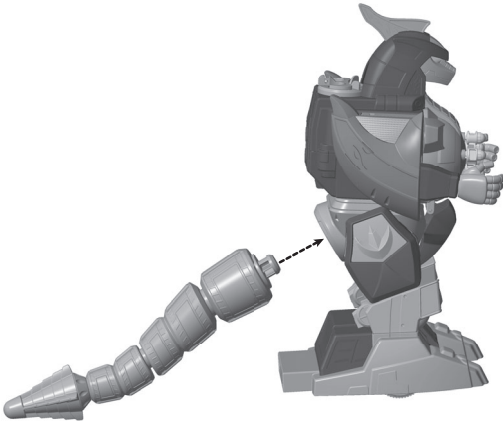

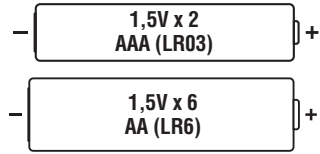

## One-Time Assembly

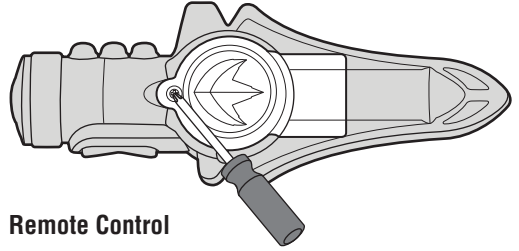


- Insert and “**snap**” the tail into the socket in Dragonzord.

## Battery Installation

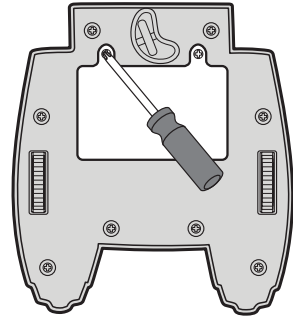


For longer life, use **alkaline** batteries.



### Remote Control

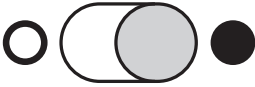
- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Insert two, new AAA (LR03) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw.



### Dragonzord

- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert six, new AA (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws.

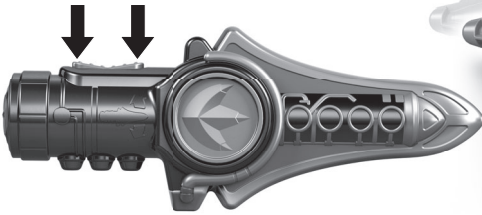

**Remote Control**

- Slide Dragonzord's power switch ON ● or OFF ○.
- Press and hold the front of the remote control switch to move Dragonzord forward.
- Press and hold the back of the remote control switch to back up and turn Dragonzord.
- Shake the remote control and Dragonzord spins and whips its tail.
- The maximum range between Dragonzord and the remote control is 12 feet (3,66 meters).
- Bright sunlight or fluorescent lights may affect the range between Dragonzord and the remote control. Try dimming the light in the room you are playing in.
- Make sure there is a clear path between Dragonzord and the remote control and there are no obstructions between them.
- We do not recommend using Dragonzord on carpets. For best performance, use on hard, flat surfaces.

## Attack!

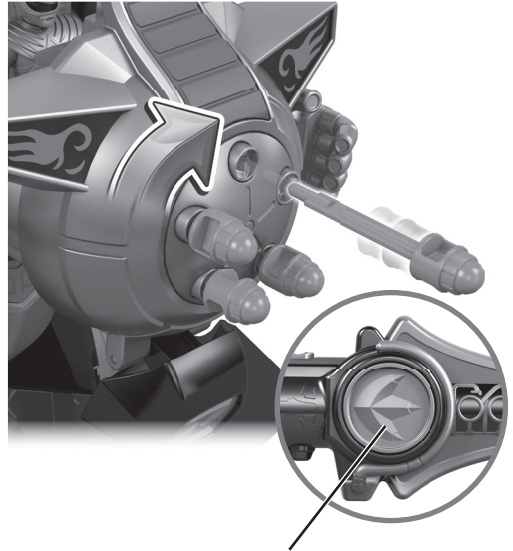


### WARNING:

- Turn the Power Pad to open Dragonzord's chest. Turn again to close.



- Press the large button on the bottom of the remote control to fire missiles!
- 
- If the remote control begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove and reinstall the batteries.
  - If Dragonzord begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power switch off and back on.

## Troubleshooting Information

- Dragonzord will enter “sleep mode” after about three minutes of inactivity. To turn this toy back on, turn the Power Pad or slide the power switch off and then back on.
- When movement/sound/lights from Dragonzord become slow/faint/stop, it is time for an adult to change the batteries in Dragonzord.
- If Dragonzord does not respond to the remote control, it is time for an adult to change the batteries in the remote control.
- If the remote control or Dragonzord are accidentally dropped in the water, remove the batteries and allow them to air dry. Replace with fresh batteries before operation.

## Battery Safety Information

**In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:**

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
